ATTORNEY ITEMS:

Decommissioning Plan for proposed Solar Farm: The Decommissioning Plan was received and reviewed by the Town Attorney with the following suggestions to the Town Board.

*Allow Planning Board to review and approve the project pending Town Board Approval.

*Bond for decommissioning received shows a high value for recycling material. The Attorney suggested removing the Recycling Material credit and increasing the bond.

*The Decommissioning Plan has the owner leaving all structures in the ground. The Town Attorney suggested adding the removal of the structures.

Supervisor Butler will send the request to Boulder Point with the Town Changes and have a meeting to discuss if necessary.

Councilwoman Denno asked how they pick the amount of the Bond. It is an estimate of what it will cost to remove and get rid of the Solar Panels and equipment at the end of use. Supervisor

Butler stated that the Town Board can review the Bond every 5 years to make changes if needed.

SUPERVISOR ITEMS:

Veterans Ceremony: The County honors local veterans throughout the County. This month they will be Honoring Korean War Veteran Earl Seelow from Corinth.

TOWN CLERK:

Archive Grant: We have received the first installment of funds from the grant and will begin updating our permanent records to electronic form.

BUILDING CODE:

*Will be attending Classes at the end of February in Lake Placid and this will cover all requirements of the year.

*CDBG Home Improvement project has come across some major issue, and it should be taken down and a modular put in.

*Beaver trapping on been done at the railroad and will soon take place at the cemetery.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Duell: Instead of the Bonds for the Decommissioning plan can they buy new panels. They could choose to add new panels, but the Bond will protect the Town if they do not replace or remove it.

James Murray: It looks like the 9N property is starting to move along. Could a letter with the layout of what is going to happen on the property be shared. Supervisor Butler stated that we are still waiting for final approval from the APA and do not want to put anything out until the approval.
